SAIGON FIVE CARD

SAIGON FIVE CARD is an exciting card game played with a standard deck of 52 cards plus one Joker.

PLAY

Players must make an Ante wager to play Saigon Five Card. Players may also make an optional Bonus wager that is based on the players five cards. Players must be seated to receive cards and remain seated throughout the round. Each player who has made an Ante wager will be dealt five cards and use them to form two hands. The first hand will have three qualifying cards that must total 10, 20 or 30 in order to qualify. The second showdown hand will have two cards with the highest point value of 10 and the lowest value of 1. If a Joker is used in either the three card hand or the two card hand it can have a point value of 3, 6 or 9.

If three of the five cards do not total 10, 20 or 30 no further action is needed by the player. The hand will either lose to a qualifying Dealer hand or push to a non-qualifying Dealer hand.

If the player qualifies and the Dealer does not, the Ante wager is paid 1 to 1 unless the players two card hand is a point total of 5 in which the Ante is paid at 1 to 2.

If both the player and the Dealer qualify the next step is to compare the two card showdown hands. If the players two card point total is more than the Dealer's two card point total the Ante will be paid 1 to 1 unless the player's two card point is 5, then the Ante will be paid at 1 to 2. If both the player's and Dealer's two card point total are the same the Ante will be a push.

BONUS BET

The optional Bonus wager must be made prior to the cards being dealt. The Bonus wager will win when the player's five cards have one of the hand types listed on the pay table and win regardless of the outcome against the Dealer. For the Bonus wager a Joker may be used as an Ace in any hand, other than the Royal Flush with no Joker, or may be used to complete a Royal Flush with a Joker, Straight Flush, Flush or a Straight.

SAIGON FIVE CARD

| Winning Hand | Pays |
|------------------------|------------|
| 5 Aces | 5,000 to 1 |
| Royal Flush - No Joker | 1,000 to 1 |
| Royal Flush with Joker | 250 to 1 |
| Straight Flush | 100 to 1 |
| Four of a Kind | 50 to 1 |
| Full House | 20 to 1 |
| Flush | 15 to 1 |
| Straight | 12 to 1 |
| Three of a Kind | 10 to 1 |
| Two Pair | 8 to 1 |

Maximum aggregate payout limit per player is \$50,000 or the maximum amount a patron could win when betting the minimum, whichever is greater.

CARD POINT VALUES

The cards in Saigon Five Card have the following point values, 2's through 10's have their denomination as their point value. Jacks, Queens and Kings have a point value of 10 and Aces have a point value of 1. The Joker can be used as a point total of 3, 6 or 9. When the two card hand has a point total greater than 10, 10 will be subtracted to get the hand point total. For example if the hand contains an 8 and a 7 (15), 10 will be subtracted to get the point total of 5.
