SIC BO

Sic Bo is an ancient Chinese game of chance played with three dice. The object of the game is to select the numbers, or a combination of numbers, that will appear on the dice after they are shaken and rolled. All betting possibilities and the payoff amounts are shown on the Sic Bo layout by showing the faces of the dice and the many combinations. There are single die numbers, two of a kind, three of a kind or combinations of any two or three dice.

To Play:

The Dealer will place the cover over the dice shaker and press the Shake Dice button. Players will then place their wagers on the sections of the layouts they choose. Each player is responsible for the correct placement of their wagers regardless if they were assisted by the dealer. Once all wagers are placed the Dealer will push the No More Bets button and then reveal the dice in the shaker. The numeric value of each die will be entered by the dealer into the electronic device on the table and each winning pattern of the layout will light up.
